Children learn in the school readiness classroom, which is designed to encourage play-based learning that supports their development of kindergarten readiness skills, including: social skills, direction following, transitioning between activities and communication in a group environment. To ensure success for families, child and parent/guardian attendance at sessions is critical. Parent/guardian attend workshops, share information, observe their children, and receive coaching and support to optimize their child's learning and facilitate the transition to school.
